R. TRUSTEES (9 maximum – Discipline says 3-9)

Responsible for administrative oversight of all church properties, for the preservation of its sanctity, and establishment and maintenance of a safe and welcoming environment for congregants and the larger community. Includes purchase, sale, mortgage, encumbrance, construction, repair, remodeling and maintenance. Regularly reviews adequacy of the property, liability, crime, and personnel insurance. Authorizes the use of church-owned properties by outside organizations and assures that such use is consistent with the Discipline. Receives and administers all gifts and legal documents for the use and benefit of the local church. Typically meet once a month. Skills: Helpful to have knowledge and skills in building construction and renovation, finance, real estate, or administration of bequests and gifts. Trustees may serve longer than 3 years.

Established to raise awareness of the visual appearance of our building and grounds -Duties may include some “hands on” work such as doing some of the tasks that have been identified or organizing and assigning work groups. Sometimes research is involved for some projects – Plans include the refurbishing of the bathrooms on the second floor of the education wing, major refurbishing of the Fellowship Hall, and providing several projects for youth choir to earn money for yearly trip and as Great Day of Service projects. Meet about 5 times a year. Skills: thinkers and doers – creative people and common sense/practical thinkers. Also need a few people with institutional memory. It would be great for members to stay longer than three years...they would increase in their knowledge of the history of the improvements – it’s easier to change membership when large projects are completed.
